### 5. <u>ELECTION OF OFFICERS</u>

Election of Nicki Barker as Chair was proposed by Ian Scott, seconded by Jan Marpole and agreed unanimously. Election of Sue Sulkin as Treasurer was proposed by Nicki Barker, seconded by Trevor Marpole and agreed unanimously. Election of Jeremy Collins as Minute Secretary was proposed by Nicki Barker, seconded by Ian Scott and agreed unanimously. The post of Social Secretary was left vacant.

### 6. <u>FINANCIAL REPORT</u>

Sue Sulkin reported as follows:

CAF Account: £23,053.60

HSBC Account: £1,036.80 (including £600 from Fete for repairs)

**Kitchen Refurbishment:** Total cost was £6,878.45 including the blinds and materials for the big clean-up. £1,375 was reclaimed for VAT, giving a net cost of £5503.45. Funding was £1.085 from village groups, £1,400 from 2010 and 2011 Fetes, £2,000 from United Charities and £1,035 grant from West Dorset DC, giving total funding of £5,520. The grant from the Fete Committee included money earmarked for new water heaters and also driveway repairs. Official opening of the kitchen would be at the Village Café in October. The Environmental Health Office would visit on  $14^{th}$  November. Mark Hammick at the Gaggle of Geese

had donated crockery, for which he was thanked.

Youth Club: The new Youth Club would commence in January 2012, run by Nicola Richardson and David Oswald. This would run at 6.30 pm each Tuesday in term-time. The old Playgroup to be asked top remove equipment not needed by the Mothers and Toddlers Group as Youth Club would have some large items for storage. Youth Club would have their own insurance and there would always be two adults in charge of the 11-15 year-olds.

**BAPS:** Buckland Newton Amateur Players would be producing a pantomime in March 2012 and needed detailed costs for use of the Hall. It was agreed that a total of £274, plus a contribution to the alcohol licence would be charged. This included use of the Hall from Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> March for the rest of that week.

**Alcohol Licence:** This had cost £70 and the money would need to be recovered from bookings.

Oil: £865 had been paid for oil.

**Bookings:** Termly bookings included Yoga (Monday), Keep Fit (Tuesday afternoons), Youth Club (Tuesday evenings), Toddlers (Wednesday mornings) and Youth Moves (Friday afternoons).

#### 7. KITCHEN CONTRACT

Remaining items were a bolt for the hatch and a 'Mind Your Head' sign.

### 8. ITEMS REQUIRING ATTENTION IN HALL

Items arising from the clean-up included problems with the drains in the car-park area and installation of 2 water heaters. Jeremy Collins undertook to contact local tradesmen for a quote.
