

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B3143 BUCKLAND NEWTON

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along B3143 BUCKLAND NEWTON between its junction with Factory Lane and The Old Chapel Stores, a distance of 850 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 2 August 2021 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 August 2021.

This Order will enable Wessex Water to carry out relining of public sewers to prolong life as part of the sewer rehabilitation project.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3146 - A352 - A37 - B3147 - B3150 - B3143

Please note there will also be a HGV diversion route in place.
