

TEMPORARY 40MPH SPEED LIMIT, B3143, ALTON PANCRAS

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic [Temporary Restrictions] Act 1991. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

When this Notice comes into effect on 31 May 2022, a temporary 40mph speed limit will be imposed upon B3143, Alton Pancras, between its junctions with Hilling Lane and Holcombe Dairy Lane, a distance of approximately 1000 metres, at such times and to such extent as indicated by the traffic signs.

It is anticipated that the speed limit will remain in force between 0930 and 1530 on 31 May 2022 whilst Openreach carry out pole testing works. The Notice will be in operation for a period of 5 days.
